Oct 25 Arrival – Yilan (B/L/D) (Wed)

Our guide and coach will meet us on arrival and transfer to a nearby restaurant for breakfast before departing for Yilan. After breakfast, drive to Yilan via the Hsuehshan Tunnel.

Yilan is a beautiful county located in northeastern Taiwan, known for its natural landscapes, hot springs, and cultural attractions such as the National Center for Traditional Arts. Visitors can enjoy hiking in the mountains, relaxing in the hot springs, and exploring the local markets and museums.

- <u>Kavalan Whisky Distillery</u> 金<u>車葛瑪蘭威士忌酒廠</u>

 Discover the art of Taiwanese whisky-making and enjoy a guided tour of the state-of the-art facilities, including the oak barrels where the award-winning Kavalan whiskies is aged to perfection.
- <u>King Car Biotechnology Aquaculture Science Center (Jiaoxi)</u>

The city is also renowned for its rich cultural heritage, delicious cuisine, and friendly locals, making it a must-visit destination for anyone traveling to Taiwan.

Taroko National Park is a stunningly beautiful nature reserve located in Hualien, Taiwan, known for its incredible marble cliffs, deep gorges, and winding rivers. - Shanyue Bridge 布洛灣吊橋 (山月吊橋)
Shanyue Bridge, also known as the Moon
Mountain Suspension Bridge, is a thrilling
attraction for adventure seekers and
nature lovers alike. Suspended high above
a lush valley, visitors can enjoy stunning
panoramic views, adrenaline-pumping
walks across the bridge, and a chance to
connect with the natural beauty of
Taiwan.



- Swallow Grotto 燕子口

Swallow Grotto is a must-visit attraction for anyone exploring Taroko National Park in Taiwan. Visitors can walk along the narrow canyon, marvel at the breathtaking views of the crystal-clear river below, and spot the hundreds of swallows that make their nests in the towering cliffs above.

- The serect passage of The Grand Hotel 圓山密道導覽

The secret passage of The Grand Hotel is a fascinating historical attraction located in the basement of the iconic Grand Hotel in Taipei. This hidden passageway was once used by political leaders and celebrities to escape undetected during times of political unrest, and visitors can now explore the maze-like tunnels and learn about the hotel's intriguing history.

- Tamsui Old Street & Mackay Historical site 淡水老街 & 馬偕博士遺跡

Tamsui Old Street is a charming pedestrianized street in New Taipei City, offering visitors a variety of shops, street food, and traditional Taiwanese souvenirs. Adjacent to the old street is the Mackay Historical Site, a beautiful park that commemorates the legacy of Dr. George Leslie Mackay. Dr. George Leslie Mackay was born in Oxford County, Ontario, Canada and was the first



Presbyterian missionary to be sent from Canada to Taiwan in 1872. He spent nearly 30 years in Taiwan, during which he established the first Western-style hospital, promoted the use of the Taiwanese language in Christian literature, and helped to establish the island's first modern school. He is considered a hero in both Canada and Taiwan for his contributions to education and healthcare in Taiwan.

- Fort Santo Domingo 淡水紅毛城

Fort Santo Domingo is a well-preserved historical site located in Tamsui, New Taipei City, originally built by the Spanish in the early 17th century, and later served as a British consulate and a Japanese colonial government building. Visitors can explore the museum and learn about the fascinating history of the fort and the various colonial powers that controlled it over the centuries.



- Tamsui Fisherman's Wharf 淡水漁人碼頭

Tamsui Fisherman's Wharf is a lively waterfront destination located in New Taipei City, offering a wide range of restaurants, shops, and recreational activities, including boat tours, fishing, and cycling. Visitors can enjoy the stunning sunset views over the Tamsui River and indulge in fresh seafood at one of the many local restaurants.

- Bay of Two Colors (pass by) 陰陽海 (車內欣賞)
The Bay of Two Colors, located in Kenting National Park, is a breathtaking sight where the blue waters of the Pacific Ocean meet the green waters of the Taiwan Strait. Visitors can enjoy swimming, snorkeling, and other water activities while marveling at the stunning contrast of colors in the



bay.

Jinguashi Remains of the 13 Levels (photo stop) 金瓜石十三層遺址 (拍照) Jinguashi Remains of the 13 Levels is a historic site in Taiwan that was once a gold mining town during the Japanese colonial period. Today, visitors can explore the remnants of the town, including old mining tunnels and buildings, while enjoying stunning views of the surrounding mountains and coastline.

Jiufen Village 九份老街

Jiufen Village, also known as "The Old Street of Jiufen," is a charming mountain village located in northeastern Taiwan that is famous for its narrow alleys, teahouses, and traditional shops. Visitors can immerse themselves in the rich history and culture of Taiwan while sampling local delicacies and enjoying breathtaking views of the mountains and sea.
